Post Hosts Red Cross Blood Drive July 6, 2017

Someone needs a blood transfusion every two seconds. Heart surgery requires 6 pints of blood, a cancer patient needs up to 8 units of platelets, a liver transplant takes 20 pints of blood, and trauma victims may need as many as 50 pints of blood just to be stabilized. One pint of blood can save three people: the red blood cells may go to one person, the platelets to another, and the plasma to yet another. There are over 300 million people in the United States. Approximately 40% are eligible to give blood, yet less than 10% do, and 25% of our population will require a blood product during their lifetime.

We are sponsoring a Red Cross Blood Drive at the Post on July 6, 2017. We have approximately 400 members in our Post Legion Family. Our goal is 50 units. Please come. Let's show what we can do.
